How to Become a Program-Participating Contractor

To become a Residential HVAC Service Program-Participating Contractor, prospective partners will be required to enroll in the program, attend all required program trainings, and maintain applicable insurance requirements and state and trade licensing. Contractors will be required to perform all HVAC assessments and service in accordance with the program's standards, and successfully complete a drug screening and background check.
